Handle Height Adjustment







Using the handle position lever (Fig A)

Lower the handle to a comfortable working position (Fig B).

Fitting the Top Tank


Fit the top tank to the machine (Fig C).
Fit both vacuum and floor-tool hose to the separator (Fig D).





Fitting the Brush / Pad

HT4045/TT4045G require a 450mm brush or a 400mm pad. TT4055G requires a 550mm brush or a 500mm pad.





Featuring the Nuloc brush system (Fig F).

The brush is simply pushed and twisted to lock, making fitting and removal a simple process. The Pad is retained using Numatic's own PadLoc system (Fig E) (ask your supplier for details). Only use manufacturer supplied brushes / pads.

Fit the brush / pad onto the Nuloc drive chuck, twist to lock the brush / pad in place. (Fig G).

Safety gloves are recommended for the changing of used brushes.













To tip the deck into the down position (Operating mode).

Press in the brush deck locking pin (Fig H) and rotate the brush deck (Fig I & J).

To change to brush deck up position, (Transit mode) simply lift the deck and the spring loaded locking pin will activate to hold the deck up.












The vacuum hose has a U-bend clip which creates a


U-bend in the hose preventing water spillage when the vacuum is switched off.

If you need to remove the U-bend clip for any reason always ensure it is refitted correctly before you resume operation.














Fitting the Floor Tool

The floor tool has been designed for quick fitting, allowing easy squeegee blade replacement and a safety knock-off feature if the floor tool gets snagged, whilst in transit.

Note: It is easier to fit the floor tool if the weight of the machine is resting on the brush. Ensure the brush is fitted first.








Fit the floor tool and retain using the detent pins. (Fig O, P & Q)


Push waste collection pipe onto the floor tool; ensure a tight fit. (Fig R)

Note: DO NOT push the vacuum hose onto the floor tool with the floor tool in the raised position.


Raise the floor tool for transit or lower for cleaning operation using the lifting handle fitted to the back of the machine. (Fig S)








Filling the Clean-Water Tank







To fill the clean-water tank, use the FLEXI - FILL pipe from either a tap or hose pipe (Fig T, U &V).

The large cap on the left can also be used for filling from a bucket or suitable container (Fig W).







Great care must be taken to ensure that contaminants (leaves, hair, dirt, etc.) are not allowed to enter the clean water tank during the filling process.

If using a bucket or similar, ensure it is always clean and free from debris.









Fill Level Indicator

Fill the clean-water tank to MAX line indication on tank, including cleaning chemicals if required.

Follow chemical manufacturing guide lines.

The clear dump hose at the rear of the machine can be used to see the level of the clean-water (Fig X).

Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH)

For best results use a non-foaming type of chemical recommended for use in auto scrubber dryers, dilute to the manufacturers specification. For further guidance on hazardous substances refer to health and safety instructions online.











Water Flow Adjustment

Turn on the clean-water tap. (Fig Y)

Adjust water flow using the fluid control tap. (Fig Z)



Reset Switch (100-120V Only)

Press re-set switch to reset machine after trip out.



IMPORTANT



Do not operate machine unless the Operator Manual has been read and fully understood.

The machine is now ready to be moved to the cleaning site.

Before performing the cleaning operation, place out appropriate warning signs and sweep or dust-mop the floor.


Lowering the Floor Tool


After preparing the floor (see previous section), we are now ready to set the controls to suit the cleaning conditions.

Before any settings can be applied, ensure the brush deck is lowered.

Move the floor tool lever to its lower position. (Fig A & B)

Note: Do not pull the machine backwards with the floor tool in the lowered position, this could possibly damage the blades.







Break-away Floor Tool

The floor tool design incorporates a break-away feature.

Allowing it to safely disengage from its mounting should it become caught on an obstruction, during forward machine movement.





To re-attach the blade to its holder:

First loosen the retaining knobs on the floor tool body and slide onto the holding bracket. (Fig C)

Tighten retaining knobs to finger tight. (Fig D)

Pre-scrub Mode

On heavily soiled floors use a 'double scrub' technique.


First pre-scrub the floor with the floor-tool in the raised position, allow the chemical time to work, then scrub the area a second time with the floor-tool lowered.




Setting the Cleaning Controls


Ensure your TT machine has been plugged into a suitable power supply. (Fig E)

Switch on the Vacuum (F) and the water pump (G).










To operate the machine squeeze lever (1), then press yellow lever (2).

Releasing the Levers (1) will stop the machine.



Floor-tool in use

The clean-water / chemical mix is dispersed via the 'THRU-FEED' system.

The waste water is then retrieved by the floor-tool.

Overlap the scrubbing path by 10cm to ensure an even clean (Fig H).


If streaking occurs, wipe the floor-tool blades clean (Fig I).



NOTE:

Care must be taken to reduce speed when cornering or when manoeuvring around obstacles



Remove the two hoses to disconnect the separator from the machine (Fig 1).

Whilst pulling the top tank separator toggles up and inwards, remove the separator. (Fig 2)


The separator has a sealing rubber which should be examined at every clean-down.


Rinse the separator using clean water, remove the vac filter, clean and inspect for any damage. (Fig 3)




Never use the machine without the recommended filter as it may cause damage to the machine.


Remove debris basket filter and rinse using clean water, and refit. (Fig 4)


















- After use, empty waste water tank using emptying hose and flush out with clean water.
- B Next remove floor tool vacuum hose and flush out with clean water.
- Next empty clean water tank, using emptying hose and again flush out with clean water.

IMPORTANT

If the debris basket is allowed to become clogged, vacuum performance can deteriorate.

Located under the left hand side is a clean water filter, make sure the clean water tank is empty before removing this filter.

Note: To make access easier, raise the brush deck.




Changing the Floor Tool Blades



ALWAYS ENSURE THAT THE MACHINE IS SWITCHED OFF PRIOR TO MAINTENANCE.





To clean the floor tool, remove securing-pin and pull-free from the holder.


Rinse the floor tool assembly with clean water and refit.


Periodically the floor tool blades should be examined and checked for wear and damage.


The blade removal is easy. Simply start by removing the four retaining pins, turn the floor tool over and separate the blade carrier from the body.


Peel away the blades from their locating lugs and examine or renew as required.

Replacement is a reversal of the removal process.










Floor Tool Overview

Note: The blades are designed to be reversible, thus extending their useful working life.







Schematic Diagram




Daily
Keep the machine clean.
Ensure brushes / pads / squeegee / filters are in good condition.
Check for any worn or damaged parts and replace immediately.
Drain and rinse dirty water tank after every use.

Weekly – as daily and – Check brush / pad and deck skirt, wipe and rinse. Check floor tool blades for wear and wipe clean. Clean separator assembly including filter and check condition of seal. Flush out system with clean water and clean filters.



Do not use on cleaning surfaces having a gradient exceeding that marked on the machine. While on ramps or inclines, avoid sudden stops. Avoid sharp turns. Use low speed down ramps. Clean only while descending (driving down) the ramp.

This machine is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Only use brushes provided with the appliance or those specified in the instruction manual.

The use of other brushes may impair safety.

A full range of brushes and accessories are available for this product.

Only use brushes or pads which are suitable for the correct operation of the machine for the specific task being performed.

It is essential that this equipment is correctly assembled and operated in accordance with current safety regulations.

When using the equipment always ensure that all necessary precautions are taken to guarantee the safety of the operator and any other persons who may be affected.

Wear nonslip footwear when scrubbing. Use a respiratory mask in dusty environments.

When cleaning, servicing or maintaining the machine, replacing parts or converting to another function the power source shall be switched off. Mains operated machines shall be disconnected by removing the power plug, and battery operated machines shall be disconnected by using top ON/OFF button on the battery.

Machines left unattended shall be secured against unintentional movement. When detergents or other liquids are used, read the manufacturer's instructions.

Do not allow the supply cord to come into contact with the rotating brushes or pads.





Off-Aisle Cleaning Kit (Optional Extra Accessory)




The optional off-aisle cleaning kit gives added flexibility to the operator.

Remove the vacuum hose from the floor tool and attach to the off-aisle kit.

To operate the vacuum, press the vacuum switch on.
